### Delbert's Corner:

*Ask Delbert for a clear answer to that nagging question or to learn something new.*

**Question:** What is the difference between Cold Rolled Steel (CRS) and Galvanneal? And why does HMX supply Galvanneal product as standard?

**Answer:** CRS is processed by running steel through a series of rolling mills until it reaches the desired thickness. At this point, the steel is very stiff, so to make it more easily bent and avoid springback, the steel must be annealed (heated to high temperatures) to soften and make it useful. CRS is typically furnished with a light oiling which must be cleaned before a prime coat is

applied. Frame fabricated from CRS are best used in interior applications where moisture and rusting are NOT an issue. Galvanneal products undergo additional processes which protect the steel from oxidizing and rusting. This is done by coating the steel using molten zinc, then heat treating to convert the entire coating to a zinc-iron alloy. The finished product has excellent resistance to rust, is resistant to fabrication damage, and has a non-spangled matte finish that requires no pretreatment and accepts paint very readily. While priming is not necessary, HMX provides its doors and frames fabricated from A60 Galvanneal with a coating of rust-inhibitive primer. This combination of zinc-iron alloy coating and rust-inhibitive primer provides superior corrosion resistance.
